Bits—Hands On Construction and Design By Bit Space

TUE | Grades 2—8 \$291

Our Hands-On Design and Construction class is a next-generation shop class for budding young makers and creative problem solvers. Students participate in hands-on design and construction projects utilizing a combination of hand tools and small power tools to craft things from real materials. Chess Scholars THU | Grades K—8 \$164
