Guitar Club

In Guitar Club, we use well-known tunes from movies, video games and of course rock and roll to give students a fun and motivating introduction to the instrument and a reason to practice at home. To ensure that students continue to progress and grow as musicians, Guitar Club uses a Three Year-Three Tier Curriculum developed by Fine-ArtsMatter so students never repeat a song over a three year period while they are consistently challenged by three tiers of difficulty within each les-
