Chess Enrichment By Chess-Ed

WED | \$193 Grades 1—8

Electronic Engineering

By Kids STEM Studio

Breadboard circuits are a great way for the students to learn about real electronic components and circuit design. Students learn building circuits with LEDs, batteries, resistors, capacitors, transistors and Light Dependent Resistor. End of the course, students get to take home the breadboard projects.
