All Girls Beginner's Chess By Dynamic Chess FRI | Grades K—5 \$151

Chess is typically a male dominated game, and some girls find being outnumbered by boys to be intimidating in the classroom. Dynamic Chess wants to create an optimum learning environment for girls, and for every student! If your daughter wants to be in an all-girls class and a co-ed class, she is more than welcome to join both! Your child will be taught the basics of chess by a female chess instructor. They will learn things such as how the pieces move, piece values, what is a check, checkmate, and stalemate. Each child will also learn good opening principles, positional concepts, and common checkmate patterns.
